

Choosing an Electronic Health Record (EHR): Checklist

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Your EHR is one of the foundations of your practice. Before choosing one be sure to assess the following:

- Determine all the features you need.
- Assess the ease of use and applicability for your specialty area(s).
- Test a number of systems with the same data for at least 3 different hypothetical patients.
- Assess the compatibility with your hardware.
- Carefully assess data security and alignment with HIPAA requirements.
- Be sure you understand what levels of customer support are offered.
- See how frequently product updates are made.
- Be sure to be clear about the cost for all the features you need.
